




How to Support Your Child at Home in Music

<p>Making Instruments: Try creating shakers by using pasta and rice in empty bottles.</p>	<p>Empty plastic bottles/plastic containers with lids. <p>'Sound Walk': Together with your child you could explore the sounds heard on different journeys.</p>	<p>N/A</p>	<p>Listen out for sounds on journeys with your child. E. g. What does the journey to the park sound like - what may we hear on the way?
